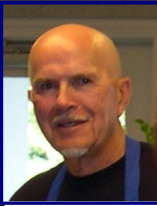

I have been selected as January's Knight of the Month. I am being recognized for the time I volunteer to do the publicity for the events put on by the Knights, the monthly Newsletter that I edit and publish, and for hosting, with my lovely wife Diana, the Knight's Christmas Party.

Rather than pointing out my other interests, I'm going to use this spot to give you an update on my health. I was recently diagnosed with a brain aneurysm. It was discovered during a routine CAT scan of the head looking for a reason to account for a hearing loss in my left ear. After numerous consultations with various doctors in the area, we were fortunate to obtain a referral to Dr. Sehkar at Harborview Medical Center. Dr. Sehkar is considered one of the top Neurosurgeons specializing in high risk cases. The procedure to be performed will be an actual bypass of the aneurysm followed by a clip. I have scheduled surgery for May 28th and barring any complications I should be discharged from the hospital in 4 - 6 days with a recovery period lasting 4 -6 weeks. Diana plans to keep all updated, you are free to call our home to get updates (425-488-4109). The fortunate thing is that I have no symptoms and I am maintaining a normal life. I have put myself on the prayer list, please keep me in your thoughts and pray for a positive outcome and a speedy recovery.

**The latest on Brother Vern's progress (courtesy of Shirley & Merlin Endres):**

**(As of 1/31/10)**

This week we have a rather short but pretty good update. Vern was discharged from the hospital early this afternoon. He weathered this round of chemo better than any in the past, and as of tonight is feeling pretty good, although tired. Even with having a treatment each day since Tuesday, he wasn't really bothered by the nausea like in the past, and so far has not had an elevated temperature.

He has an appointment at the Cancer Care Alliance clinic tomorrow afternoon. They will do a blood draw and if needed will give him a transfusion of either whole blood or platelets. Lets hope he doesn't need either.

We now start the healing time for his blood, which is anticipated to take about two weeks. At that time they will again do a marrow biopsy, with a second one scheduled about a week later. That last one will again be a part of the prep starting over again for the transplant. So the delay is about a month, give-or-take depending on how everything goes. The schedule will take more shape as time goes by over the next couple weeks. I'll keep you posted on how it goes....
